



## East Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office Reserve Division

### 2011 Statistics

### ***"Where there was a need, the need was met"***

In 2011, the Reserve Division provided **24,028 hours** of volunteer service to the East Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office. The economic benefit provided by this Division was approximately **\$721,000**.

The Reserve Division handled **2,448 files** and provided coverage for **1,651 shifts** at the various substations.

More than **105,000 miles** of patrol through our parish highways, roads and streets provided the visual coverage to make our parish safer and better. **616 businesses** were checked and **482 field interviews** conducted during the patrols.

The Warrant Division of the Reserves served **1,706 papers** which resulted in **52 arrests**. Uniform Patrol made **164 misdemeanor arrests**, **48 felony arrests** and **1,037 traffic arrests** in 2011.

The Reserve Traffic Division, which operates the Junked Vehicle Abatement Program initiated in 2010, investigated and assisted in the removal of **1,286 junked vehicles**. This represents approximately 1,000 tons of scrap metal which is no longer an "eye-sore" along the roadways within our parish. This division also investigated **18 motor vehicle crashes** in 2011.

The East Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office Reserve Division provided a security to numerous public events within the parish. Central's "Cooking for Kids", Pennington Balloon Festival, Special Olympics and C.O.P.S., are just few of the major events that the Reserve Division work each year.

Reserve Deputy Instructors provide training assistance for the range, the Field Training Operation and for CARTA.

Professional, efficient and ready to serve this parish, the Reserve Division of the East Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office is there to meet the need.
