- a perfect word for a division that touches almost every area of the East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Office. The Reserve Division is comprised of seven divisions; Uniform Patrol, Warrants, Traffic, Range, Communications, Corrections and Support Services.

Presently, fifty-six Deputies are assigned to the Reserve Division who contributed 25,888 hours of time for 2010. The economic benefit that the Reserve Division provides to the East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Office is approximately \$ 725,000.00.

Reaching into the core of the parish, Reserves patrolled 96,205 miles of roadway, filling 1,606 shifts in the process and logging 660 business checks.

With professional dedication, Reserve Deputies handled 2,471 files which resulted in 384 arrests. The Warrants Division served 1,543 civil warrants and 123 criminal warrants.

Reserve Traffic worked 72 motor vehicle crashes. While patrolling the roads of our parish, Uniform Patrol and Traffic issued 1,605 traffic citations and warnings which helps provide for safer neighborhoods for our families to enjoy.

A recently initiated Vehicle Abatement Program was established by the East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Office and spearheaded by Deputies from the Reserve Division. This program has investigated 641 abandoned or inoperative motor vehicles, many of which are no longer in the parish making for a better environment for all.

When it comes to public outreach programs, the Reserve Division steps up to serve. More than twenty outreach programs, such as the Cooking for Kids, Pennington Balloon Championship, Special Olympics and Mary Byrd Perkins Cancer Event and civic parades, are just a few that Reserve Deputies have worked this year.

Reserve Deputies are involved in the training process of many of the deputies that are serving this agency. Working in close relationship with CARTA, Reserve Deputies provide staff assistance for the Reserve Academy. Reserve Deputies are utilized in firearms training, giving 935 hours of time at the range as firearms instructors. The concealed carry course sponsored by the East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Office, is another program that Reserve Deputies work with.

2010 saw a strong growth in all of the divisions of the Reserve Program. The East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Office Reserve Program, an investment that produces large dividends in the quality of life that the citizens of our parish enjoy.
