EBRSO Arrests Parent For Making Threatening Remarks to Students

East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Deputies responded to Magnolia Woods Elementary, 760 Maxine Drive, today in reference to a parent making threatening remarks to a class of 5th grade students and their teacher.

Donna Wilson, 44, of 2575 Gardere Lane Lot # 88 is charged with Terrorizing.

According to reports, Wilson arrived at the school to check her child in this afternoon around noon. While checking the child in, Wilson was informed by school administration of possible bullying that occurred yesterday toward her child. She was told that school administration handled the situation and counseled the students in reference to teasing her child. After checking the child in, Wilson allegedly escorted the child to the fifth-grade classroom. While in the classroom Wilson allegedly confronted the teacher and students about bullying her child and threatened to have her husband return to the school, and made threatening remarks referencing the school-shooting incident in Connecticut. Wilson was escorted from the classroom and left the campus.

School administration contacted the Sheriff's Office and the school was placed on "Hold and Secure" as a precautionary measure. Detectives located Wilson at her home and took her into custody. Wilson said she made the statements because she felt her child was being bullied and she wanted the children to understand about not bullying. She also said she did not mean to reference Connecticut, and she was sorry for making the statement. She will be transported and booked into parish prison on the above listed charge.
