**EBRSO Arrests Three in Shooting**

East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Detectives arrested three people yesterday in connection with a shooting that occurred earlier in the day.

Joyrie Knighton, 25, of 4756 Enterprise St. is charged with Attempted First Degree Murder (4 counts) and Illegal Use of a Weapon.

Raven Harris, 19, of 3001 Toronto Dr. is charged with Principal to Attempted First Degree Murder (4 counts).

Garrett Burton, 18, of 3336 Laurel St. is charged with Principal to Attempted First Degree Murder (4 counts).

According to reports, deputies responded to a call of shots fired on Wednesday at approximately 2:29 p.m. in the 3000 block of Vancouver Drive. Deputies learned that three individuals were standing outside of a residence when they were approached by Knighton, Harris, Burton and a 16-year-old male. According to reports, the two groups began to argue. Knighton then allegedly took a weapon and began firing shots at the three individuals. No one was hit. A bullet struck a residence on Quebec Drive that was occupied by one person at the time of the shooting.

According to reports, the two groups have been involved in an ongoing

dispute. Detectives located the suspects at an address on Toronto Drive. Harris was taken into custody without incident. Deputies located Knighton and Burton in the attic of the residence. Detectives are still looking for the juvenile involved in the shooting. Investigation is ongoing.
